You must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April one year to 5 April the next) that is at least equal to the tax that 5th Dorking (URC) Scout Group will reclaim on your payments for that year.

The Scout Group will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 that you give up to 5 April 2008; 25p on every £1 that you give on or after 6 April 2008; and the Government will pay to the Scout Group and additional 3p on every £1 that you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the Scout Group does not affect your personal tax position.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include your Gift Aid donations on your self assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
